



Name the Canadian Master Contest

1. Name the Canadian Master Contest (the "Contest"), sponsored by the Royal Canadian Golf Association operating as and hereby, "Golf Canada," commences at 10:30am ET on October 29, 2020 and concludes at 9:00 pm ET on November 12, 2020 (the "Contest Period").
2. How to Enter:
 1. Visit <https://golfcanada.ca/masters-contest/> to complete and submit the contest form.
 2. No purchase necessary. Any active Golf Canada membership, regardless of level, is eligible for the Contest.
3. The Contest is open to all residents of Canada who are 18 years of age or older at time of entry, except for employees of Golf Canada, employees of their Provincial Associations, affiliates advertising or promotional agencies, or members of those persons' respective immediate families, or anyone with whom any of those persons are domiciled. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.
4. There is one grand prize available valued at CAD \$500.00.
5. The prize is subject to the conditions, restrictions, expiry dates, requirements and regulations noted on the prize certificates and applicable at the time of delivery and use. The prize is not transferable or sub-dividable and will be awarded to the confirmed winner only. The prize is not convertible to cash and must be accepted as awarded.
6. A random draw for the prize will be made at the Golf Canada office in Oakville, Ontario on November 15, 2020 at 11:00am ET from all eligible entries received during the contest period. The odds of winning a prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received for the Contest during the Contest Period.
7. Golf Canada will attempt to contact the selected entrant via email and/or telephone for approximately one (1) week following the draw, between 9:00 am ET and 7:00 pm ET. If Golf Canada is unable to contact the selected entrant after three (3) attempts, the submission will be rendered null and void and another selected entrant will be chosen. This procedure will be repeated until a selected entrant has been contacted within the given time. In order to win the Prize, the selected entrant must have complied with the official contest rules, correctly answered the arithmetical skill-testing question to be administered by email, and sign and return Golf Canada's standard declaration and release form which will be sent by email. The prize will be forfeited if the declaration and release form is not returned to Golf Canada within 15 days after prize notification. Prizes must be accepted as awarded, without substitutions or transfers. Any additional costs incurred in using a prize are a winner's responsibility.
